NEW SINGLE FOR KINGSKIN

KINGSKIN have their five-track "Humpin' Mojo" EP released in association with Zebra 3 Records and promote it with a release party at Stripes club in Folkestone on Saturday April 28th where they will be joined by T*A*R and TORTILLA ARMY.

The ep is officially released on May 7th and will be on sale at the Music Room in Folkestone's Guildhall Street, all HMV shops (catalogue number Z3EP01), via Amazon, iTunes, cdbay.com and at the band's gigs.

KINGSKIN also play at the Beacon Court in Gillingham on Sunday April 22nd; the Railway Inn, Winchester on Monday April 23rd; the Boilers Arms in Guildford on Thursday April 26th; the Net in Abingdon on Friday April 27th; and the Astor Theatre in Deal on Sunday April 29th.

For KINGSKIN, if the crowd isn't dancing, then the gig isn't happening and they like their gigs to happen. KINGSKIN isn't a passing fad or fashion, this is a band that is unable to be pigeonholed due to their unique sound that they describe as a mix of funk and grunge and their penchant for emphasising an individuality that most bands can only crave.

KINGSKIN have come along way after cutting their teeth in Folkestone and Dover and a lot has changed for them since those days when they were voted Kerrang's "Best Unsigned Band". A recording contract with indie label Diablo Music made the band label mates with one of John Peel's favourite acts and they have been on the road extensively around the UK, establishing themselves as one of the most energetic and compelling live acts around. The band has built up an ever-growing fanbase by supporting the likes of Hell is for Heroes, Million Dead and Hard-Fi.

When Diablo were bought out at the beginning of last year by a larger, pop based label, the band resolved to distance themselves from an increasingly suffocating situation. The resulting legal issues effectively grounded KINGSKIN until late last year, when free of contract and in possession of their recorded material, they successfully released their debut single "Last Ride Home" as an iTunes exclusive in October.

KINGSKIN take their influences from the early 90s grunge scene and influential artists such as Nirvana and The Clash plus the explosive stage performance's of The Red Hot Chili Peppers. Their sound is a raw mix of funk-grunge mixed with thumping, finely tuned guitar riffs that are reminiscent of Led Zeppelin's early style grooves interspersed with raw whiskey soaked vocals, which creates the bands eclectic and diverse sound.

KINGSKIN's debut album is due for release in October, with the band having worked with producer/engineer George Shilling, who has also worked with big names such as Primal Scream, Bullet for My Valentine, Blue and James Brown. For further information, visit www.kingskin.com

CONCRETE JUNGLE, CAMBER SANDS

SHAM 69, COCKNEY REJECTS, DISCHARGE, GBH, VICE SQUAD and ANTI NOWHERE LEAGUE are among the 60+ acts playing the Concrete Jungle Music Festival at Pontins Camber Sands on the weekend of April 20-22. Also playing are New York street punk band THE TEMPLARS and KOOPA, the first unsigned band in history to make the top 40 through downloads. There's also PERKELE from Sweden, AGITATORS from Belgium and other acts from Greece, Germany and various other countries.

The Chaos Sessions are being held to give brand new, younger, lesser well-known bands the chance to get on stage and perform, therefore encouraging the next generation to carry the torch forward in the true spirit of 1976 punk rock.

Anti establishment, corporation controlled pop idol is the order of the day ... back to youth culture, songs with a message, experimentation, angst and real guitars. After the main bands, there is cabaret for the early hours to include all sorts of madness. Entertainment starts at 6pm on Friday April 20th and then from noon-4am on both the Saturday and Sunday.

NEW VENUE FOR LONE STAR

The Lone Star Comedy Club returns on Saturday April 21st at a new venue - the Leas Club in Folkestone. Acts at the Leas Club are ROB ROUSE, DAVE INGRAM, compere AMADEUS and a newcomer's act.

Since winning Channel Four's prestigious 'So You Think You're Funny?' competition at the Edinburgh Festival in 1998 - an award previously won by Phil Kay, Dylan Moran, Lee Mack, Tommy Tiernan and Peter Kay - ROB ROUSE has been a regular performer at major venues on both the London and national circuit.

Rob has returned to Edinburgh three times: in 1999 compering The Comedy Zone at the Pleasance and co-wrote and performed The Big and Daft Comedy Show, winning critical acclaim and returning in 2000 with Big and Daft in Space, and in 2001 with The Big and Daft Christmas show, massive hits with critics and punters alike.

Rob has toured with Phil Kay, taking him both to Hungary and Poland and has recently returned from a tour of Amsterdam.

Compere AMADEUS Martin has quickly made his mark on the stand-up scene. He was part of the University gang who set up the first pirate radio station to hit South Wales, going on to host his own show. During his gap year he moved to the Canary Islands and captured the resident DJ spot in the region's premier R&B club.

A playful character, AMADEUS has a quick-witted, cheeky, personable style, and his observational humour is energetic and direct. He loves speaking trivia, and the current news, but will sooner speak his mind than be politically correct.
