## **MORE THAN NORMAL, JESTER and T. A. R. AT LEAS**

Dover-based band MORE THAN NORMAL kick off a four-month tour with arguably their biggest gig to date when they headline the Leas Cliff Hall in Folkestone on Friday January 28th, with support from punk band JESTER and ska group T. A. R.

Formed in 2001, MORE THAN NORMAL are an awesome, high energy pun rock band that will get even the most jaded head nodding. The band's sound is a fusion of the very best US punk (Blink 182, Green Day and Rancid) combined with a dash of good old UK street punk (The Clash, Buzzcocks, Filth F. C.).

More Than Normal come across as a welcome breath of fresh air with their on stage shenanigans and have-a-laugh attitude which has won them rave reviews up and down the country. After near constant gigging throughout Kent, the band have already embarked on two nationwide tours and have previously supported such luminaries as Farse, Shootin Goon, Captain Everything and the Not Katies.

The band have recently slimmed down to a three-piece consisting of Al (drums), Ben (vocals and guitar) and Gaz (bass).

The gig will also herald the release of More Than Normal's new EP 'Late Nights, Messy Mornings'. They previously released an album entitled 'Playin' Dumb' in 2002. The tour is with Moon Ska's latest heroes Fandangle and will keep More Than Normal on the road until the end of May. JESTER have themselves previously headlined the Leas and need little introduction to local gig goers. They provide a punk rock antidote to the offerings of chart music and, as well as their own material, blast out classic punk rock covers from the late 70s (including songs by the Sex Pistols, Stiff Little Fingers, The Clash and The Damned) and more up-to-date acts. The band deliver with a big modern sound and entertain both musically and visually by involving the crowd with their interactive live performance. Each show is typified by a raw energy that never fails to come across.

New Folkestone-based band T. a. R. serve up fast energetic ska punk in a minor key and are made up of Aaron Darveniza (drums / vocals), Chester Boyd (bass / vocals), Matt Stewart (guitar), James Gillard (sax / vocals) and Matt Davey (trombone).

## **LONE STAR COMEDY CLUB**

The Lone Star Comedy Club enters its second year with BRENDAN BURKE (star of Father Ted and Liffy Laughs), SHAZIA MIRZA (as seen of Have I Got News For You and the country's only female Muslim comedian), DARRELL MARTIN (who has supported both Johnny Vegas and Ross Noble on tour) and resident compere DANNY JAMES at the Lanterns in Folkestone's Rendezvous Street on Saturday January 22nd.

BRENDAN BURKE is one of the finest and most experienced acts from the Emerald Isle. As a regular face on Irish television and resident compere at Gibneys in Malahide, he has cemented his reputation in Ireland and is now looking to make his assault on the UK. Already a crowd favourite at many venues across the country, Brendan's take on all things from the drinking habits of his native folk to whatever happened in the news the day before is sure to win him many more fans.

Trained at the Rose Bruford College of Speech and Drama in London, SHAZIA MIRZA works full time as a writer, actor and stand up comedian. She began stand up comedy in September 2000 and has in a very short space of time worked her way up the ladder, picking up the 2001 Hackney Empire Best New Act competition at the London Comedy Festival (part of the prize was to appear at the Palladium). She followed this up by winning Metro Magazine's People's Choice Best Comic Award at the London Comedy Festival in 2002.

Shazia's distinctive act combines a deadpan delivery with observation on her world. In certain respects she is a revolutionary figure being the UK's only female Muslim stand up, a job which many in her culture would frown upon. This enables her to have a unique perspective as a British Muslim with her material crossing both cultures.

She was invited to perform at the Royal Albert Hall V Day event when Eve Ensler asked her to write her own monologue which she duly did and received a standing ovation from a cast which included Isabella Rossellini, Maureen Lipman, Rita Tushingham, Meera Syal, Dannii Minogue and Anita Dobson. Shazia Mirza is a practising Muslim.

In 1999, DARRELL MARTIN supported Perrier Nominee Johnny Vegas on a 50-date 'Walking Back To Happiness' tour. His material is a mix of observations taken down a ridiculous avenue, philosophical questioning of simple matter and some basic downright dirty stuff. His regular compering work has honed his ability to chat with the crowd, enabling him to pick up on fresh ideas, and weave material and improv.

The Comedy Club now switches to the third Saturday of each month.
