PUNK NIGHTS AT THE LANTERNS

THE VARUKERS, SHORT BUS WINDOW LICKERS, THE SLUGS and SECOND STREET play at the Lanterns in Folkestone on Friday January 26th.

THE VARUKERS were formed in Leamington Spa in 1979, and are now based in Nottingham. One of the lead bands of the second wave of punk, they took on the harder sound that came from bands such as Discharge. In fact, their singer Rat stood in as the singer of Discharge in 2003, when after reforming and recording, original singer Cal refused to tour. Rat remained the singer for Discharge to this day, and is currently co-writing material for their next album. SHORT BUS WINDOW LICKERS hail from South London and are in the same vein as The Varukers, and basically are mad (it says here). This will be the first time this far south for both bands.

THE SLUGS and SECOND STREET are both Kent-based urchins. Tickets are £5 on the door. SICK ON THE BUS and AIRBOMB then play at the Lanterns on Saturday February 4th.

And the big news is that DISCHARGE play at the Lanterns on May 25th and UK SUBS return on August 5th, so put those into your new diaries. For further information, visit www.chaosagency.co.uk

LONE STAR COMEDY CLUB

MATT WELCOME, DAVE DYNAMITE, COLIN OWENS and new mc DAN WILLIS appear at the first Lone Star Comedy Club of the New Year at the Lanterns in Folkestone on Saturday January 21st.

MATT WELCOME is an established headline act on the UK comedy circuit with television credits to his name that include 'Live at Jongleurs' (ITV). Matt took a couple of years out to 'find himself' and is now back performing, fresher and sharper than ever!!! He took a sell-out show called 'What you can do' to the Edinburgh Festival in 1996 and became a favourite headline act at Jongleurs comedy clubs around the country in the late 1990s. He made his comeback in January 2003 after being persuaded to perform in a benefit at a local school by a friend, saying 'it was a little strange but I got back in the groove very quickly I did 45 minutes straight off, it was quite cathartic'.

After a short spell as an underpant model for Freemans catalogue, DAVE DYNAMITE turned his hand to freedom fighting in Columbia. As a mercenary Dave, or the 'Butcher of Croydon' as he was known, found he had a gift for telling jokes. Although not a lot of his victims laughed as they 'was blindfolded and shot like dogs'. Forced to resign from his career as a bus driver after an incident involving a llama, him dressed in a giant chicken outfit with a huge strap on, was captured on the bus cctv. Wound up like a ticking alarm clock, prepare yourself for 20 minutes of vein throbbing anger and utter stupidity which will be forced down your throat like a cocktail on a club 18-30s holiday.

One man wrestling with his anger and you get to watch!

A many of many confusions, father of three and husband of one, CLIVE OWENS lives in tropical Southampton. He first tried comedy in March 2005 having had an indistinctive career. Now at 36 he says things are desperate. He won Jimmy Carr's Comedy Idol and appeared at Bloomsbury Theatre with Mr Carr. Can comedy save his bacon?

One of the fastest rising and hardest working acts on the circuit, DAN WILLIS is a quick thinking, fast talking stand-up comedian who can be seen at most of the premier comedy clubs and festivals in this country and abroad, having had sell out runs at both Melbourne and Edinburgh comedy festivals. He has quickly built up a reputation as a solid comper who can control a room and keep a crowd laughing throughout a night, no matter how long that night may be and no matter how many acts are on the bill.

Having started out as a Panellist on the Perrier Awards (after winning the TimeOut Edinburgh Festival comedy competition in 2001), DAN WILLIS has starred in and presented a number of Shows for network television including 'Kings of Comedy' and 'Edinburgh or Bust'. Dan has also worked tirelessly as a crowd warm-up person for shows such as 'Open House with Gloria Hunniford' where for six months he daily entertained a crowd of 80-year-old ladies without swearing or naughty sex talk - though his stand-up routine can switch effortlessly from clean to adult material depending on how the crowd want to go.
