TORTILLA ARMY

TORTILLA ARMY are a four-piece original band with a twist – in a word 'percussion'. Claiming influences from punk, pop, metal and latin, they have recently released their debut album "A New Journey".

The band formed back in 1998, primarily as a three-piece rock covers band, but as their first gig was fast approaching, an original song was penned for convenience. The song went down so well that they wrote some more.

The band is Jim Noble (guitar/lead vocals), Mick 'Fish' Gaffney (drums), Colin Lovatt (percussion) and Sy Morton (bass/backing vocals).

The album was recorded at Astra Audio in Monks Horton and produced and engineered by Rob Williams and the band.
