## **CUBIC SPACE DIVISION, MY LIFE IN THE MAKING and CAR CRASH TELEVISION AT LEAS**

CUBIC SPACE DIVISION headline the Leas Cliff Hall in Folkestone on Friday April 1st, with support from MY LIFE IN THE MAKING and CAR CRASH TELEVISION.

Kent metal quartet CUBIC SPACE DIVISION was formed by guitarist / vocalist Jamie Floate, who briefly played with earthtone9 around the time the Nottingham noise oiks recorded their monumental 'arc 'tan' gent' album. Since their incarnation in 2001, CUBIC SPACE DIVISION have already received critical acclaim and have released a self-titled album.

If you are searching for metal to take you on an epic journey of modern soundscapes, then CUBIC SPACE DIVISION's experimental sonics are just the ticket. Exploring the depths of light and dark, sometimes claustrophobic, sometimes uplifting, the album is a journey into the realms of atmospheric metal. It was recorded by Martin Barbour at Philip Studios, Oxfordshire and mastered by Joe Gibb (Million Dead, Johnny Truant, Funeral For A Friend) at Mighty Atom Studios in Swansea. From the pumping rock of action of 'Red Shift' and the groove friendly 'Per Se' to the brooding dark forces contained within 'Silhouette' and 'Bear The Tide', CUBIC SPACE DIVISION offer truly intelligent songs which fly in the face of the norm. The band is Jamie Floate (guitar / vocals), Olly Smith (guitar / vocals), Olly Craggs (bass) and Simon Ziolkowski (drums). MY LIFE IN THE MAKING were known for four years as Hindsight and will be launching their debut "Contemplating Concepts of Forever" album on Zebra 3 Records at the gig. The album features ten roundhouse blows of passionate melodic metal and has been recorded/produced by Andy Hawkins (former bass player with Midget). It will be distributed through Proper Music Distribution.

Whilst citing heavyweights such as Glassjaw, Tool, Deftones, Thursday, Medicine Head and Faith No More as their main influences, MY LIFE IN THE MAKING are intent on creating a name for themselves for what they sound like, not an identikit of their influences. 'Contemplating Concepts of Forever' is a passionate offering which maintains its British accent whilst looking set to charm audiences globally. Having already shared stages with Lostprophets, Biffy Clyro, Hundred Reasons and Sparta, the band is looking to step it up a notch on the back of the new album and make the leap into the spotlight. They have a UK tour planned from April to August and will then head to the USA for an autumn tour culminating at the Mid point Festival in Cincinnati, Ohio. The band comprises Ken Graham (vocals), Ted Clark (guitar/vocals), Sam Alfatt (bass) and Tom Alfatt (drums).

Looking like some bizarre marionette tug-of-love struggle between Gerry and Sylvia Anderson, MARTIN DAVIS skids and bounces across the stage, strung up and tugged around by unknown forces, firing off a relentless rapid-fire assault that hits every corner of the room and kills 100% of all known hecklers stone dead. Going where mere joke-tellers fear to tread with his characteristic kamikaze bravado, he walks the razor edge of audience participation, daring them to pick him off it. With enough nervous energy to power a small city, Martin is the Jolt Cola of the circuit. Advice would be: connect up the microphone, shout "Clear" and stand well back.

WIL HODGSON was the winner of the Perrier Awards Best Newcomer award for 2004 and is fast establishing himself on the stand-up circuit as an original and unique voice. Pete has performed at, and compered, clubs all over London and in his hometown of Melbourne and is resident compere of the Comedy Tree in Putney.
