NEW ALBUM FOR JESTER

Punk band JESTER officially launch their new "Corruption" album with a date at spiritual home the Happy Frenchman in Folkestone on Saturday May 1st.

The band say that the new album is a lot harder than 2001 debut 'Down With The Clown' and has a political edge, for which they make no apologies, it's just how they were feeling when they wrote the songs. But there is also some light-hearted stuff on there as well, so don't despair.

There are 11 new tracks on the album and four recorded live covers at the end and it's on sale for just £10.

JESTER have become one of the area's most popular bands since forming in 1996 when bored with the offerings of chart music and endless record company produced mindless dross being forced down everybody's throats. They decided to create a punk rock antidote and played their first gig in Dover in 1997 bashing out classic punk covers from the late 70s including songs by the Sex Pistols, UK Subs, The Undertones, The Buzzcocks, The Clash, The Damned and many more.

As well as their own material, JESTER play music that has either influenced them, or they enjoy, from the bands mentioned above to more up-to-date acts like the Offspring and Blink 182. JESTER deliver with a big modern sound and entertain both musically and visually by involving the crowd with their interactive live performance. Each show is typified by a raw energy that never fails to come across.

JESTER also play at the Louis Armstrong in Dover on Saturday May 14th and the White Lion in Cheriton on Saturday June 5th.
