CANTERBURY FESTIVAL

The Canterbury Festival takes place between October 9-24, with a host of international arts, exhibitions and music events throughout the city. Highlights include a gig by THE WATERBOYS at the Marlowe Theatre on Tuesday October 12th and a return appearance from local legends CARAVAN, also at the Marlowe on Sunday October 17th. The festival begins with dancing in the streets of the city on Saturday October 9th.

The SOWETO CHOIR come direct from South Africa to the Marlowe on Monday October 11th, while SAMMY RIMINGTON joins THE KEN COLYER TRUST for some New Orleans jazz at the Theatre Royal in Margate on Saturday October 16th. Spanish guitarist and composer EDUARDO NEBLA plays the Gulbenkian Theatre on Tuesday October 19th and BLACK VOICES sing at the Theatre Royal in Margate on Thursday October 21st.

The EURO JAZZ PROJECT are at Shirley Hall in The King's School on Saturday October 23rd and THE UKULELE ORCHESTRA OF GREAT BRITAIN play the Gulbenkian Theatre, also on Saturday October 23rd.

Comedy comes in the form of LENNY HENRY at the Marlowe Theatre on Friday October 15th, the Keith Barret Show at the Marlowe on Saturday October 16th, LINDA SMITH at the Gulbenkian Theatre on Saturday October 16th, Peter Searle's 'Hey Gringo! Through Peru' at the Gulbenkian Theatre on Monday October 18th, Peepolykus at the Gulbenkian Theatre on Wednesday October 20th and JASON BYRNE at the Gulbenkian Theatre on Friday October 22nd.

BILLY CHILDISH offers some 'poetry' & blues at the Horsebridge Arts Centre in Whitstable on Thursday October 14th.

The Festival Club is based at the Canterbury Environment Centre (St Alphege's Church, off Palace Street) and hosts a selection of jazz, folk and world music. Amongst the performers here are THE FAT CATS (Saturday October 9th), LAS BRAGAS (Thursday October 14th), JIM LEVERTON (Thursday October 21st) and R CAJUN & THE ZYDECO BROTHERS (Saturday October 23rd).

There are numerous free lunchtime concerts at St Gregory's Centre of Christ Church College in North Holmes Road.

ALBUM LAUNCH FOR INTENSIFIED

Nine-piece traditional ska / reggae / rocksteady band INTENSIFIED will be launching their new "Doghouse Bass" album with a date at the Beer Cart Arms in Canterbury on Tuesday October 19th and then head overseas for dates at Hafenklag in Hamburg on Thursday October 28th, Roter Salon in Berlin on Friday October 29th, Conne Island in Leipzig on Saturday October 30th and Skater's Palace in Münster on Sunday October 31st.

Guaranteed to get people dancing, INTENSIFIED are really up for the challenge of keeping the authentic styles of both Jamaican ska/rocksteady and British Trojan reggae alive. 
