LOCAL BANDS AT LEAS

MY JULY, APV and STANXA play the Leas Cliff Hall in Folkestone on Friday September 10th and then on Friday October 8th you can see INTENSIFIED launch their new 'Doghouse Bass' album.

MY JULY describe themselves as 'a drum 'n' bass emo band with an experimental grunge rage' but are at pains to point out that they are not 'your average emo band'. Influenced by the likes of Metallica, Silverchair, Slash and various emo drum 'n' bass sounds, the band has been around for about 18 months during which time they have released a three-track cd which glories in the name of "The Room Is Getting Smaller .. The room Is getting Longer". The band consists of Andy Wiltshire (lead guitar), Dave Wiltshire (drums), Kieron Mercer (vocals), Jake Wilson (guitar) and Jake Miller (bass).

From starting as a metal band less than a year ago, hat wearing, split doing, duck walking rockers APV (it stands for A Pyrrhic Victory) have come on in leaps and bounds in just a few short months. Officially they have only been a working band for less than six months when a gig offered itself in the form of Mr. Gig's 2nd birthday party at Stripes Club in Folkestone. Since then, their music has been wanted by venues such as the White Lion Hotel and King's Hall in Herne Bay. They have just had a month's break to work on new material and are hitting the Leas with no less than five new tracks. 'Cock Rock' is how they describe their genre as it not only describes their music but also their lifestyle. Their older tracks, available on their demo 'Ain't So Bad', portray them as a hard rock band, however the newer tracks have blues, bluegrass, and psychedelic influences. STANXA formed in the summer of 2000 and have been gigging since day one. They have recently completed their third UK tour this year to critical acclaim, leading to talks with producers who are interested in taking the band to the next level. The band has been described as 'Morrissey on crack'. The contrast between the harmonious and passionate vocals tied with the powerful, rapid, meatiness of the music makes the band really stand out. NEXT COMEDY CLUB NIGHT


